Objectives for the academic year (2022-23)

Our priority is not just subjects, instead we aim at a Holistic education focussing overall development of our students. Student Enrichment Programmes:

waste materials, cooking without fire, painting on different things, speech writing, calligraphy, storytelling, reading competition and spell bee. To cope up with this competitive society, it is necessary for our students to get updated with current affairs, Plenty of Quiz contests were conducted to develop their general knowledge and intellectuality. An Inter School competition also organized under the ages of Sahodaya Group. To promote various life skills and holistic development of the students, motivational lectures, Outreach Programmes were organised where students can have a brief knowledge of emerging technologies like AI, Block Chain, Cyber Security, 3D Printing, Robotics. Art Exhibition, Science Exhibition, was held in the school which showcased the projects, models and other activities done by the students. Good health of students is a primary concern of school.
